CIRCULAR

Sub: Selection of personnel in Public Sector Undertakings -
Streamlining of - Instructions issued - Modified.

Ref: 1. Circular No. 14896/BPE2/91/Plg., dated 28th February 1992.
2. Circular No. 16340/BPE2/96/Plg., dated 20th September 1997.

As per the Circular 1st cited, Government have decided that the recruitment to Managerial and Professional posts in Public Sector Undertakings carrying basic salary (excluding D.A. and other allowances) of Rs.1500/- per month and above shall be made by selection from the applications received through sufficient advertisement in News papers. As per the Circular 2nd cited, the above salary limit of Rs.1500/- per month, mentioned in sub-para (ii) of the Circular 1st cited, was enhanced to Rs.2000/- per month (excluding D.A. and other allowances)

Government have now examined the matter in detail whether the quantum of the above basic pay of Rs.2000/- p.m. is to be enhanced further. It is found that it has been enhanced every 5 years in the past and now more than 7 1/2 years have elapsed after the last enhancement. Considering the above facts it is found proper and reasonable to raise the said salary limit again.

In the circumstances, the salary limit mentioned in sub-para (ii) of the Circular 1st cited is enhanced to Rs. 3000/- per month (excluding D.A. and other allowances)

The instructions issued in the Circulars cited stand modified to the above extent.
